- 2. if a noun ends on -ch, -o, sh, -ss, -x, we add es church/churches;
- 3. if a noun ends in a consonant and -y, y is changed to ies

4 some plurals are irregular or don't change.

baby/babies, hobby/hobbies the

Note: In German: Hobbys

man/men

Examples

Two is one plus one. /

Come to me. /

Yes, you too.

I have a tear in my eye.

Common spelling mistakes

Correct NOT successful succesfull beautifull beautiful recieve receive

Similar but different **Examples**

loose/lose Your shoelaces are **loose**. / Don't **lose** your money!

desert/dessert In the **desert** there is no rain. / After the meal we got **dessert**.

The train is **stationary**. (not moving) / Pens and paper are **stationery**. stationary/stationery

That is a **personal** question and is none of your business. / personal/personnel

The **personnel** work at the company.
